The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact resulting in the following impact.

The amendment requires the Commissioner of Consumer Protection to submit a detailed report on flame retardant chemicals resulting in a cost of approximately \$100,000 in FY 23 for staffing to complete the report.
