### ***OFA Fiscal Note***

#### ***No Fiscal Impact***

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment makes various changes to statutes governing banking department licensees, increases surety bond amounts for consumer collection agency licensees, restricts who is considered an obligor, and makes other technical and conforming changes to the banking statutes. The amendment also requires the Department of Banking (DOB) to add additional considerations in the approval of certain loan production offices, establishes a working group, and authorizes the DOB commissioner to adopt regulations to implement a law that allows certain lenders to repossess goods. These changes are not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.
