Explanation

The amendment delays the effective date from October 1, 2022 to January 1, 2025 and therefore delays the state and municipal impact of indicated in the fiscal for the underlying bill from FY 23 to FY 25.

The amendment also requires the Department of Insurance to complete a benefit review pursuant to 38a-21 of the general statutes which is anticipated to cost at least \$200,000 in FY 23 to contract with a third party to conduct the review.
