The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment impacts the finances of the Connecticut Health Insurance Exchange ("exchange"), which is a quasi-public state agency that is largely funded through a marketplace assessment on certain health insurers.

The amendment requires that, beginning October 1, 2022, any proposal to increase an assessment or user fee charged by the exchange must be subject to a public hearing and legislative and board approval as described by the amendment. To the extent these requirements prevent the exchange from otherwise increasing the marketplace assessment or charging a user fee, the amendment precludes a future revenue gain to the exchange in those instances.

The amendment also requires the exchange to provide additional annual reporting to the legislature. The exchange may incur contract costs to report the results of a cost benefit analysis, as required by the amendment.
