**"AN ACT CONCERNING ADOPTION OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS
OF THE TASK FORCE TO STUDY CANCER RELIEF BENEFITS FOR
FIREFIGHTERS."**

1 Strike section 9 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Sec. 9. Subsection (c) of section 31-382 of the general statutes is
3 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
4 *passage*):

5 (c) [Any] (1) Except as provided in subdivision (2) of this subsection,
6 any employer who has received a citation for a violation of the
7 requirements of sections 31-369, as amended by this act, and 31-370, of
8 any standard or order promulgated pursuant to section 31-372, or of
9 regulations adopted pursuant to this chapter, which violation is
10 specifically determined not to be of a serious nature, may be assessed a
11 civil penalty of up to one thousand dollars for each such violation.

12 (2) In the case of a violation described in subdivision (1) of this
13 subsection by any volunteer fire department or volunteer ambulance

14 company, such volunteer fire department or volunteer ambulance
15 company shall be issued a written warning, except for (A) a violation
16 occurring within one year of a previous violation by such volunteer fire
17 department or volunteer ambulance company, which does not result in
18 serious harm to any person, such volunteer fire department or volunteer
19 ambulance company shall be assessed a civil penalty of up to two
20 hundred fifty dollars, and (B) for a violation occurring within one year
21 of a previous violation by such volunteer fire department or volunteer
22 ambulance company, which results in serious harm to any person, such
23 volunteer fire department or volunteer ambulance company shall be
24 assessed a civil penalty of up to one thousand dollars."
