"AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESSENTIAL WORKERS COVID-19 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM."

Strike subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of section 1 and insert the following in lieu thereof:

3 "(1) "Affected person" means an essential employee who died or was 4 unable to work as a result of contracting COVID-19, or due to symptoms 5 that were later diagnosed as COVID-19, at any time between March 10, 2020, and July 20, 2021, provided: (A) The contraction of COVID-19 by 6 7 such employee is confirmed by a positive laboratory test or, if a 8 laboratory test was not available for the employee, as diagnosed and 9 documented by the employee's licensed physician, licensed physician 10 assistant or licensed advanced practice registered nurse, based on the 11 employee's symptoms; (B) a copy of the positive laboratory test or the 12 written documentation of the physician's, physician assistant's or 13 advanced practice registered nurse's diagnosis is provided to the 14 administrator; and (C) such employee, during the fourteen consecutive

15 days immediately preceding the date the employee died or was unable 16 to work due to contracting COVID-19, (i) was not employed in a 17 capacity where the employee worked solely from home and did not have physical interaction with other employees, or (ii) was the recipient 18 of a written offer or directive from such employee's employer to work 19 20 solely from home but otherwise chose to work at a work site of the 21 employer. "Affected person" includes a person employed at a business 22 that was forced to shut down by the state as a result of the public health 23 and civil preparedness emergencies declared by the Governor on March 24 10, 2020, and any extension of such emergency declarations. "Affected 25 person" does not include a federal employee who qualifies for benefits 26 under the COVID-19 workers' compensation presumption included in 27 the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021;"

28 Strike subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of section 1 and insert the 29 following in lieu thereof:

30 "(2) "Affected employee" means an essential employee who, at any 31 time between July 21, 2021, and July 20, 2022, is unable to perform the functions of such essential employee's job due to an eligible reason for 32 33 leave, provided an affected employee shall not include an essential 34 employee who (A) during the fourteen consecutive days immediately 35 preceding the eligible reason for leave, was employed in a capacity 36 where such affected employee worked solely from home and did not 37 have physical interaction with other employees, or (B) was the recipient of a written offer or directive from such essential employee's employer 38 39 to work solely from home but otherwise chose to work at a work site of 40 the employer. "Affected employee" includes a person employed at a 41 business that was forced to shut down by the state as a result of the 42 public health and civil preparedness emergencies declared by the 43 Governor on March 10, 2020, and any extension of such emergency 44 declarations;"
