sHB 6776

***AN ACT CONCERNING A PASSIVE MEDICAID REDETERMINATION
PROCESS FOR CERTAIN AGED, BLIND OR DISABLED
RECIPIENTS.***

SUMMARY

This bill requires the Department of Social Services (DSS) commissioner to determine an enrolled HUSKY C participant's continued eligibility based on available asset and income data in accordance with federal law and without the participant having to reapply for eligibility or take other action. This "passive Medicaid redetermination" requirement applies (1) for HUSKY C participants with stable financial circumstances who receive long-term care services and (2) only when DSS has access to sufficient information to do so in accordance with federal law.

HUSKY C provides Medicaid coverage for people who are at least age 65, blind, or living with a disability.
