The Committee on Energy and Technology reported through SEN. NEEDLEMAN of the 33rd Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROCUREMENT OF ZERO-CARBON RESOURCES FROM ELIGIBLE NUCLEAR POWER GENERATING FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Energy and
2 Environmental Protection shall conduct a study regarding the potential
3 need for future solicitations for zero-carbon electricity generating
4 resources from eligible nuclear power generating facilities, as defined in
5 section 16a-3m of the general statutes. Not later than February 1, 2024,
6 the commissioner shall report, in accordance with the provisions of
7 section 11-4a of the general statutes, the results of such study to the joint
8 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
9 matters relating to energy and technology.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
