Explanation

The bill requires the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (PURA) with prescribing forms regarding requests for reinstatement of utilities by owners of certain rental properties after a shutoff request has been made. This has no fiscal impact on the state.

Senate "A", has no fiscal impact by making additional modifications to the types of properties impacted by procedure regarding utility service terminations.
