Explanation

The bill, which eliminates governmental immunity as a valid defense in a civil suit involving negligent operation of a motor vehicle, results in a potential cost to municipalities beginning in FY 24. The provisions of the bill do not impact the rights and exemptions of emergency vehicles. Any potential costs would vary based on the amounts awarded to plaintiffs and the number of suits brought annually.

As the bill applies only to political subdivisions of the state, there is no fiscal impact to the state itself.

House "A" alters the original bill to prevent the elimination of governmental immunity from impacting the rights and exemptions of emergency vehicles.
