Explanation

The bill may result in a potential cost to the state and municipalities to ensure all state and local buildings that contain combustible gas be equipped with a gas leak detector by July 1, 2025. There will be a cost to the state and municipalities in FY 24 and FY 25 to the extent they must install new gas detectors in buildings.
