Explanation

The bill allows the Department of Motor Vehicles to require that persons with a school bus or student transportation vehicle license submit to state background checks periodically, resulting in a potential revenue gain to the state to the extent additional background checks are conducted. The Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection (DESPP) conducts state background checks for a \$75 fee per person. DESPP may conduct fingerprinting for a \$15 fee per person, paid to the Applicant Fingerprint Card Submission Account.¹

The bill also makes various changes to the government administration statutes resulting in no fiscal impact to the state.

¹ Funds in the non-lapsing Applicant Fingerprint Card Submission Account are used for IT support and maintenance for the fingerprinting systems.

The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to the number of background checks conducted by DESPP.
