REASONS FOR BILL:

This bill makes various corrections and repeals an obsolete statute of the public safety statutes. The legislation makes several technical corrections to various sections, such as Subsection (d) of section 23-26, which pertains to fire wardens' ability to request state forest personnel for assistance in fighting forest fires. Subsection (b) of section 27-102p, which concerns the Commissioner of Veterans Affairs' annual report publication, and Subsection (c) of section 28-30, which outlines employment requirements for telecommunicators, were also amended. Additionally, Section 12-570b of the general statutes, which involves the suspension of Powerball ticket sales, was repealed.
