**AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY TREATMENT AND
TRANSPORTATION OF POLICE DOGS INJURED IN THE LINE OF
DUTY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow emergency medical
- 2 services personnel to provide emergency treatment to a police dog
- 3 injured in the line of duty, and to transport such police dog by
- 4 ambulance to a veterinary clinic or similar facility equipped to provide
- 5 emergency treatment for dogs, provided there are no individuals in
- 6 need of emergency treatment or transportation at the time.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow emergency medical services personnel to provide emergency
treatment and transportation to police dogs injured in the line of duty.
