AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION TO CONDUCT A STUDY AND SUBMIT A REPORT CONCERNING KRATOM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 21a of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Department of Consumer Protection, within available resources, to (1)
- 3 study the effects of kratom on the health of adults and children, and (2)
- 4 submit, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
- 5 cognizance of matters pertaining to consumer protection, a report
- 6 containing (A) the results of such study, and (B) the department's
- 7 recommendations concerning kratom regulation.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Consumer Protection to study the health effects of kratom and submit a report containing the results of such study and the department's recommendations concerning kratom regulation.
