**AN ACT CONCERNING QUALIFYING CONTRIBUTION AMOUNTS TO  
PARTICIPATING STATE-WIDE OFFICE CANDIDATES UNDER THE  
CITIZENS' ELECTION PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 157 of the general statutes be amended to increase to one
- 2 thousand dollars the maximum amount an individual may contribute
- 3 to the qualified candidate committee of a state-wide office candidate
- 4 who is participating in the Citizens' Election Program.

To increase to one thousand dollars the individual qualifying  
contribution amount for state-wide office candidates under the Citizens'  
Election Program.
