AN ACT IMPLEMENTING TRAFFIC-CALMING MEASURES IN THE TOWN OF HAMDEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 To require the Department of Transportation to designate funding for
- 2 (1) the study and development of a design plan to implement traffic-
- 3 calming measures and a road diet for Dixwell Avenue and Whitney
- 4 Avenue in the town of Hamden that includes, but need not be limited
- 5 to, narrowing roads, limiting access for certain size motor vehicles,
- 6 designating parking and no-parking areas, improving traffic control
- 7 signal lights, installing sidewalks and crosswalks and improving
- 8 conditions for pedestrians and bicycles, and (2) the implementation of
- 9 such plan.

Statement of Purpose:

To implement traffic-calming measures on Dixwell Avenue and Whitney Avenue in the town of Hamden to reduce traffic and improve public safety.
