**AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR
DIAGNOSTIC AND SCREENING COLONOSCOPIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 700c of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 individual and group health insurance policies to provide full health
- 3 insurance coverage, without any out-of-pocket expense, for (1)
- 4 diagnostic and screening colonoscopies, and (2) any necessary medical
- 5 procedure preparation when recommended by a health care provider
- 6 within such provider's scope of practice.

Statement of Purpose:

To require individual and group health insurance policies to provide full health insurance coverage, without any out-of-pocket expense, for (1) diagnostic and screening colonoscopies, and (2) any necessary medical procedure preparation when recommended by a health care provider within such provider's scope of practice.
