**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADJUDICATION OF CERTAIN CRIMES
WITHIN THE GEOGRAPHICAL AREA WHERE SUCH CRIMES WERE
COMMITTED.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require crimes involving
- 2 violence, theft of a motor vehicle, sexual offenses and offenses involving
- 3 the use of a firearm to be adjudicated in the geographical area where the
- 4 offense occurred, not where the perpetrator resides.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce an additional burden on crime victims by requiring certain crimes to be adjudicated where the offense occurred.
