AN ACT PROHIBITING ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION COMPANIES FROM RECOVERING LOBBYING COSTS FROM RATEPAYERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 16 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit electric
- 2 distribution companies from recovering in rates any costs associated
- 3 with lobbying, hiring lobbyists, or advocating for legislative action.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit electric distribution companies from recovering lobbying costs from their ratepayers.
