AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CREDIT AGAINST THE PERSONAL INCOME TAX FOR STUDENT LOAN PAYMENTS MADE BY CERTAIN TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 229 of the general statutes be amended to establish a
- 2 credit against the personal income tax for student loan payments made
- 3 by individuals actively employed as teachers in a preschool, elementary
- 4 or secondary education program.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a credit against the personal income tax for student loan payments made by individuals actively employed as teachers in a preschool, elementary or secondary education program.
