***AN ACT CONCERNING CAMPAIGN FINANCE AND PARTY
ENDORSEMENT AND NOMINATION SCHEDULES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to (1) increase to one
2 thousand dollars the maximum amount an individual may contribute
3 to the qualified candidate committee of a state-wide office candidate
4 who is participating in the Citizens' Election Program, (2) increase to ten
5 million dollars the general election grant amount for gubernatorial
6 candidates participating in said program, (3) apply the same schedule
7 for endorsements and nominations to all major and minor political
8 parties, (4) move the parties' presidential preference primaries to the
9 earliest in the calendar year without resulting in a reduction of such
10 parties' delegates to the national party conventions, and (5) increase to
11 twenty-five thousand dollars the maximum amount an individual may
12 contribute to state central committees.

Statement of Purpose:

To implement several changes to campaign finance laws designed to reduce barriers for certain candidates.
