**AN ACT REQUIRING A VIRTUAL FINANCIAL LITERACY SEMINAR
FOR STUDENT LOANS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10a of the general statutes be amended to require the Office
- 2 of Higher Education to (1) create a virtual on-demand financial literacy
- 3 seminar concerning student loans for access by students enrolled in any
- 4 institution of higher education or private career school in the state that
- 5 assists or provides students with access to loans for the payment of
- 6 tuition or other costs, and (2) require each such institution or school to
- 7 receive notice from the office verifying a student has completed the
- 8 financial literacy seminar prior to allowing such student to accept a loan
- 9 annually.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the development of a virtual student loan financial literacy
seminar and to require students to complete such seminar before
accepting a student loan.
