AN ACT CONCERNING THE IDLING OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to codify the existing
- 2 prohibition on the idling of motor vehicles for more than three minutes,
- 3 contained in section 22a-174-18 of the regulations of Connecticut state
- 4 agencies, and authorize the enforcement of such restriction by
- 5 municipalities in addition to the Department of Energy and
- 6 Environmental Protection.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize municipal enforcement of a state agency regulation prohibiting the idling of a motor vehicle for more than three minutes.
