AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR M-DAY SERVICE MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL GUARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) establish a property tax
- 2 exemption of one hundred thousand dollars of the assessed value of a
- 3 primary residence in the state for any member of the National Guard
- 4 who serves part-time and is required to participate in drills one
- 5 weekend per month and in fifteen days of annual training each year,
- 6 and (2) reimburse municipalities for the resulting revenue loss from the
- 7 General Fund.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a property tax exemption of one hundred thousand dollars of the assessed value of a primary residence in the state for any M-Day service member of the National Guard and reimburse municipalities for the resulting revenue loss from the General Fund.
