**AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS FOR
RETIRED TEACHERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 167a of the general statutes be amended to require (1)
- 2 the Teachers' Retirement Board to offer Medicare Advantage and
- 3 Medicare supplement coverage, that includes medical, prescription,
- 4 vision and hearing benefits, that have substantially equivalent coverage
- 5 and benefits, and (2) that the cost of the Medicare supplement coverage
- 6 be paid as follows: (A) One-third subsidy appropriated by the state, (B)
- 7 one-third subsidy by active teachers through the health insurance
- 8 premium account within the Teachers' Retirement Fund, and (C) one-
- 9 third by retired teachers' premiums.

Statement of Purpose:

To restore one-third state subsidy to retired teachers enrolled in the Teachers' Retirement Board Medicare supplement health insurance package.
