AN ACT CONCERNING STUDENT ASSESSMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That (1) the Department of Education be required to (A) audit, with
2 funds available through the federal Every Student Succeeds Act or other
3 federal funds, the costs and time spent by school districts and state
4 agencies implementing mastery examinations; and (B) propose
5 recommendations for a more streamlined system of student assessment
6 and a plan for fewer assessments, and (2) the general statutes be
7 amended to establish a Collaborative on Education Assessment and
8 Innovation, led by educators, to (A) study and report on education
9 performance assessments based on student performance assessments
10 and school quality measures; and (B) implement a pilot program with a
11 consortium of school districts of various sizes to carry out a model based
12 on the findings of the study.

Statement of Purpose:

To audit the costs and time spent implementing mastery examinations with the goal of making such implementation more cost and time-

effective and to establish a pilot program for an innovative model of student assessment and school quality measurement.
