**AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF FIRE DRILLS AND
CRISIS RESPONSE DRILLS DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-231 of the general statutes be amended to require a
- 2 local or regional board of education to (1) conduct a fire drill not later
- 3 than thirty days after the first day of school and at least one additional
- 4 fire drill before March first of the school year, (2) conduct at least one,
- 5 but no more than two, crisis response drills during the school year and
- 6 that such crisis response drills have been developed with an appropriate
- 7 local law enforcement agency, and (3) provide educators with an age-
- 8 appropriate explanation that they may share with students for why such
- 9 crisis response drills are being conducted.

Statement of Purpose:

To conduct fire drills and crisis response drills in a more appropriate and sensitive manner during the school year.
