**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TUITION REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM
FOR GRADUATES OF MEDICAL SCHOOLS PROVIDING MENTAL
HEALTH SERVICES IN THE STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a tuition
- 2 reimbursement program for graduates of medical schools in the state
- 3 who provide mental health services and who reside and work in the
- 4 state for not less than ten years after graduation and use such rebate for
- 5 a down payment on the purchase of a home in the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a tuition reimbursement program for graduates of medical
schools in the state who provide mental health services for the purpose
of addressing the shortage of such services in the state.
