AN ACT REQUIRING THE POLICE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING COUNCIL TO DEVELOP A POLICY PERMITTING POLICE OFFICER INTERACTIONS WITH THE PUBLIC WITHOUT THE USE OF BODY-WORN RECORDING EQUIPMENT UNDER LIMITED CIRCUMSTANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 29-6d of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Police Officer Standards and Training Council to develop a policy
- 3 permitting police officers to interact with the public without using body-
- 4 worn recording equipment under limited exigent circumstances.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that police officers who are off duty or otherwise do not have access to their body-worn recording equipment are able to protect the public.
