AN ACT ESTABLISHING A GREEN JOBS CORPS PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a green jobs corps
- 2 program to provide state residents economically impacted by the
- 3 COVID-19 pandemic with opportunities to learn new skills and
- 4 improve employment prospects within sustainability related
- 5 professions and resiliency and green sectors, including, but not limited
- 6 to, local agriculture, conservation, climate adaptation, renewable energy
