***AN ACT CONCERNING PROOF OF IDENTITY, CITIZENSHIP AND  
RESIDENCY FOR PURPOSES OF VOTING.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to provide that (1) prior
- 2 to being admitted as an elector, including during election day
- 3 registration, each person shall present to an election official proof of
- 4 such person's (A) United States citizenship, and (B) Connecticut
- 5 residency, and (2) prior to receiving and being able to cast a ballot, each
- 6 elector shall present to an election official a current and valid photo
- 7 identification, which identification clearly displays such elector's name
- 8 and residential address.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To require (1) persons to present proof of United States citizenship and  
Connecticut residency prior to registering to vote, and (2) electors to  
present photo identification prior to voting.
