**AN ACT CONCERNING THE POWERS OF A MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICER PROVIDING ASSISTANCE IN ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY ON REQUEST.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 54-1f of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 a municipal police officer who provides assistance in another
- 3 municipality, pursuant to the request of the other municipality's chief of
- 4 police under a mutual aid agreement, has the same arrest powers in the
- 5 other municipality as the officer has in the officer's own municipality.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To specify that a municipal police officer providing assistance in another municipality, on a request from the other municipality's police chief, has the same arrest powers in the other municipality as the officer has in the officer's own municipality.
