AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXPANSION OF THE CRISIS INITIATIVE PILOT PROGRAM THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 1,
2 2024, the Division of State Police within the Department of Emergency
3 Services and Public Protection shall, in conjunction with the
4 Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, expand the pilot
5 program known as the CRISIS Initiative: Connection to Recovery
6 through Intervention, Support and Initiating Services throughout the
7 state. At a minimum, such expanded program shall include the
8 components of the pilot program that require training for state police
9 officers, coordination between state police officers and mental health
10 professionals and referrals to facilities for mental health services.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
