AN ACT REQUIRING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE COMMISSIONER OF EMERGENCY SERVICES AND PUBLIC PROTECTION AND CENTRAL CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY FOR POLICE DETECTIVE AND OTHER TRAINING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 1,
2 2024, the Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection
3 and Central Connecticut State University shall enter into a
4 memorandum of understanding regarding the development by the
5 university of a forensic science laboratory and courses to train police
6 officers who are or seek to become detectives. Such memorandum may
7 also include provisions for the development of other programs or
8 courses by the university, such as programs or courses to train police
9 officers in investigative techniques, supervision or executive leadership.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
