AN ACT CONCERNING HOME VISITS AND EVALUATIONS BY THE COMMISSIONER OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2023*) When the Commissioner of
2 Children and Families, or the commissioner's designee, is required to
3 visit or evaluate a home (1) where a child in the care and custody of the
4 commissioner has been or may be placed, or (2) pursuant to section 17a-
5 101g of the general statutes, such visit or evaluation shall not be
6 conducted by telephonic, video or other conferencing platform if (A)
7 such child is under six years of age, (B) such child is six years of age or
8 older and not enrolled in school or being educated at home or in a
9 private school in accordance with the provisions of section 10-184 of the
10 general statutes, or (C) the immediately preceding visit to or evaluation
11 of such home by the commissioner, or the commissioner's designee, was
12 conducted by telephonic, video or other conferencing platform.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
