AN ACT PROTECTING WORKERS ON STATE-FUNDED PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) As used in this section:

2 (1) "Awarding authority" means the Commissioner of Economic and
3 Community Development and any state agency authorized to award
4 financial assistance; and

5 (2) "Financial assistance" has the same meaning as provided in section
6 32-462 of the general statutes.

7 (b) Each awarding authority shall, in the terms and conditions of any
8 agreement for financial assistance, include provisions for remedies in
9 the event the recipient of financial assistance fails to comply with any
10 applicable state or federal law, regulation, rule or executive order,
11 including, but not limited to, labor laws. Such remedies may include,
12 but need not be limited to, liquidated damages and the repayment of
13 any financial assistance provided.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
