***AN ACT CONCERNING A PASSIVE MEDICAID REDETERMINATION  
PROCESS FOR CERTAIN AGED, BLIND OR DISABLED RECIPIENTS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2023*) As used in this section  
2 "passive Medicaid redetermination" means a process by which a  
3 Medicaid enrollee is determined to maintain eligibility for Medicaid  
4 based on available asset and income data without having to reapply for  
5 eligibility or take other action. The Commissioner of Social Services shall  
6 use a passive Medicaid redetermination process for aged, blind or  
7 disabled persons enrolled in HUSKY C, as defined in section 17b-290 of  
8 the general statutes, (1) who are receiving long-term care services, and  
9 (2) whose financial circumstances are stable.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

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**Statement of Purpose:**

To authorize a redetermination of HUSKY C eligibility without action by certain enrollees based on available income and asset data.
