**AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAID.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Commissioner of Social  
2 Services shall study the efficacy of Medicaid-funded programs and  
3 whether the state can expand health care services to low-income  
4 individuals through additional Medicaid waiver programs.

5 (b) Not later than January 1, 2024, the commissioner shall submit a  
6 report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general  
7 statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly  
8 having cognizance of matters relating to human services. The report  
9 shall include, but need not be limited to, (1) a list of Medicaid waiver  
10 programs in the state and the number of individuals served, (2) waiting  
11 lists for each waiver program, and (3) recommendations concerning  
12 additional waiver programs the state should consider.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

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***Statement of Purpose:***

To study the efficacy of state Medicaid-funded programs and the need for expansion of such programs.
