**AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF MINORITY TEACHER
RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION PROGRAMS AND POLICIES IN THE
STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-156aa of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 the Task Force to Diversify the Educator Workforce, in consultation with
- 3 the Department of Education and the Minority Teacher Recruitment
- 4 Policy Oversight Council, to conduct a study and submit a report
- 5 concerning the barriers to minority teacher recruitment, and the
- 6 implementation and effectiveness of minority teacher recruitment
- 7 retention programs and policies in school districts across the state, on or
- 8 before January 1, 2024.

other issues relating to minority teacher recruitment and retention in the
state.
