AN ACT CONCERNING RANKED-CHOICE VOTING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to (1) provide, in
- 2 elections for senator or representative in Congress, for a method of
- 3 casting and tabulating votes whereby voters rank candidates in order of
- 4 preference, tabulation proceeds in sequential rounds in which last-place
- 5 candidates are defeated and the candidate with the most votes in the
- 6 final round is elected, (2) allow such a method to be used in presidential
- 7 preference primaries, and (3) allow municipalities the option to use such
- 8 a method for single-member offices.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for ranked-choice voting in elections for members of Congress and allow its use for presidential preference primaries and certain municipal elections.
