***AN ACT PROHIBITING HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS FROM
DISCLOSING TO LIFE INSURANCE COMPANIES CERTAIN MEDICAL
INFORMATION OF FIRST RESPONDERS DIAGNOSED WITH POST-
TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to prohibit health
- 2 care providers from disclosing to life insurance companies medical
- 3 information of first responders diagnosed with post-traumatic stress
- 4 disorder who seek medical treatment for suicidal ideations.

To prohibit health care providers from disclosing to life insurance companies medical information of first responders diagnosed with post-traumatic stress disorder who seek medical treatment for suicidal ideations.
