**AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES
INSTRUCTORS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 20-206mm of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 eliminate the requirement that an emergency medical services instructor
- 3 be certified as an emergency medical technician, advanced emergency
- 4 medical technician or paramedic by the national organization for
- 5 emergency medical certification.
