**AN ACT CONCERNING ACCOUNTABILITY FOR THE EXPENDITURE
OF FEDERAL FUNDS RECEIVED BY THE STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require (1) the Secretary of
2 the Office of Policy and Management to report, on a quarterly basis, to
3 the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having
4 cognizance of matters relating to transportation, environment,
5 government administration, appropriations and the budgets of state
6 agencies and finance, revenue and bonding concerning federal funds
7 received and expended pursuant to the Infrastructure Investment and
8 Jobs Act, P.L. 117-58, as amended from time to time, and post each such
9 report on the Office of Policy and Management's Internet web site; (2)
10 the Commissioner of Transportation to establish a separate page on its
11 Internet web site dedicated to the Department of Transportation's use of
12 funds received pursuant to the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act,
13 P.L. 117-58, as amended from time to time, that includes: (A) The
14 amount of funding received pursuant to said act; (B) the amount of such
15 funding that has been expended; (C) a brief description of each project

16 paid for with funding received pursuant to said act; (D) the total
17 anticipated cost of each project; (E) the current amount of such funding
18 expended for each project; (F) the anticipated or known completion date
19 for each project; (G) the current status of the project and whether it is
20 anticipated to be completed (i) on time, earlier or later than originally
21 planned, and (ii) on budget, under budget or over budget; (H) if it is
22 anticipated that the project will be completed later than originally
23 planned, the reason the project is behind schedule; (I) if it is anticipated
24 that the project will be over budget, the reason the project is over budget;
25 and (J) the actions taken to address any schedule delays; and (3) said
26 joint committees to hold a public hearing not later than ten days after
27 submission of each such report.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide accountability for the state's expenditure of funds received pursuant to the federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act.
