AN ACT WAIVING THE MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEE FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE SEVENTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-49 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to waive the motor vehicle registration
- 3 fee in the case of any person who is seventy-five years of age or older
- 4 and has owned such person's motor vehicle for at least two years.

Statement of Purpose:

To waive the motor vehicle registration fee for any person who is seventy-five years or age or older and has owned such person's motor vehicle for at least two years.
