AN ACT CONCERNING THE PREVENTION OF WRONG-WAY DRIVING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
2 Transportation to address wrong-way driving by (1) conducting a safety
3 study of all highway exit and entrance ramps in the state, (2) installing
4 wrong-way signs with actuated flashers that alert a motor vehicle
5 operator when such operator is driving the wrong way, (3) installing
6 pavement markers at such ramps, (4) installing wrong-way driving
7 detection and notification systems on exit ramps that will notify a law
8 enforcement agency when a wrong-way driver is detected, and (5)
9 broadcasting the presence of a wrong-way driver on electronic message
10 boards along the highway system and installing such electronic message
11 boards where necessary to make such broadcasts effective.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent wrong-way driving and protect all drivers in the state.
