***AN ACT CONCERNING MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL GUARD AND
MOTOR VEHICLE EMISSIONS TESTING.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 14 of the general statutes be amended to provide, for any
- 2 motor vehicle registered to a member of the National Guard, that the
- 3 emissions testing requirement for such vehicle shall be waived while
- 4 such member is serving on active duty outside of the state and until
- 5 ninety days after such member has returned to the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To waive emissions testing requirements for members of the National
Guard while serving on active duty outside of the state and for an
additional ninety days after returning to the state.
