



**AN ACT CONCERNING A REVIEW OF MUNICIPAL OPTION TAX RELIEF FOR VETERANS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective October 1, 2023*) The Office of Legislative  
 2 Research, created under section 2-71c of the general statutes, shall (1)  
 3 review all provisions of the general statutes that authorize  
 4 municipalities to enact property tax relief for veterans, and (2) prepare  
 5 a list of each municipality that, pursuant to such authorization, has  
 6 enacted such property tax relief, which list shall include details  
 7 concerning such property tax relief in each such municipality such as  
 8 the mill rate, exemption or abatement amount, qualifying income  
 9 threshold, size of the grand list and median home value. Not later than  
 10 January 1, 2024, the Office of Legislative Research shall submit a  
 11 report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general  
 12 statutes, on such review, including such list, to the joint standing  
 13 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters  
 14 relating to veterans' affairs and municipal matters. As used in this  
 15 section, "veteran" has the same meaning as provided in section 27-103  
 16 of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
