***AN ACT REQUIRING DISCLOSURE OF THE USE OF FACIAL
RECOGNITION TECHNOLOGY IN PUBLIC SPACES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that any person using
- 2 facial recognition technology to identify customers and guests in a
- 3 public space post a clear disclosure of such use.

Statement of Purpose:

To require a clear disclosure in all public spaces where facial recognition
technology is being used to identify customers and guests.
