AN ACT CONCERNING A DEMENTIA SERVICES COORDINATOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2023*) There shall be within the
2 Department of Aging and Disability Services a dementia services
3 coordinator. The dementia services coordinator shall (1) coordinate
4 dementia services in the state, (2) assess and analyze dementia-related
5 data collected by the state, (3) evaluate state-funded dementia services,
6 (4) identify and support the development of dementia-specific training
7 programs, and (5) perform any other relevant duties to support
8 individuals with dementia in the state, as determined by the
9 Commissioner of Aging and Disability Services.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To establish within the Department of Aging and Disability Services a dementia services coordinator.
